Think "Pinewood Derby". Your valve cover or "racer" is created by making a chassis, wheels and weights. Racers can be engineered in any way you want, so long as you follow the official unofficial rules, and can take on any personality or character you see fit. From lights to radios and everything in between. Have fun with it!



OFFICIAL UNOFFICIAL RULES: Racer can't exceed 24" long, 12" wide and 10" tall with a 10 lb maximum weight and a 6" maximum wheel diameter that can't exceed the front of the valve cover. Each race winner is determined by the front end crossing the finish line. This is a gravity race, no motors or moving weights. There will be heat races to narrow the field by elimination and determine the final overall winner.

Track dimensions: 4' tall, 30' long with two 14" wide racing lanes.
